

BEP SUMMER INTERN

OUR GOALS

To strengthen *your* relationship with Jesus Christ.
To impact students with the words and love of Jesus Christ.

Start Date: First week of June **End Date:** Second week of August

CONTACT: build relationships with students to understand their life and story. Basic Concept; wherever you go, you take a student with you. **20 HRS/WK**

THE WORD: lead a small group bible study for high school boys or girls; attend the middle school boys or girls bible study each week. **4 HRS/WK**

STAFF TIME: plan and organize events each week, work as a team with the Youth Director; Meet weekly for accountability, sharing and prayer. **5 HRS/WK**

YOUTH EVENTS: facilitate the events each week, participate in Middle School camp, SR HI missions trip and SR HI camping trip*. **5 HRS/WK***

STUDY: prepare to teach weekly bible study, prepare messages for youth groups, personal study of God's Word, weekly meeting with a mentor, one hour of personal devotions daily. **15 HRS/WK**

*Hours will be drastically increased during camp weeks, mission trips and retreat weekends.

FINANCIAL DETAILS

The church will pay \$3,000 for 10 weeks. In addition, each intern will receive \$30/week for professional expenses. Monday is the intern's day off.

POLICIES AND GUIDELINES

- A disciplined mouth: Always edify, build others up. No complaining, no coarse jokes or language.
- Guys and girls treat each other with respect. Model appropriate relationships between the sexes.
- Be diligent workers – guard against laziness. Treat the work privilege of personal time management with maturity, as a responsibility not to be abused.
- Work as a team with the other Youth Ministry Staff. This includes communication, humility and integrity. Help your co-workers. If you see a hole or a need, work together with the group to do your best to help or fix it. Help around the office when needed.
- Plan phone time with other interns to avoid back up and lag time. No extended personal phone calls at office on church time. No personal long distance calls at any time.
- Music can be played during work hours if it doesn't bother other team members.
- Wear appropriate dress. You are a role model and teacher for students and personal dress is part of your responsibility.
- Greet and always be polite to parents. Remember that they are a vital part of our ministry and are here year round. Introduce yourself as an intern and interact with them. Parents appreciate learning about you and your role in the ministry.
- Driving students: seatbelts required, must observe speed limits, appropriate music only.
- Must be above reproach in all you do and say.
- Each Intern will be provided an adult mentor with whom they will meet weekly.
- The BEP youth ministry staff will provide weekly oversight, accountability, team building and training.
