"For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord." Romans 6:23

Jesus came to set all things right!

"For Christ died for sins once for all, the righteous for the unrighteous, to bring you to God. He was but to death in the body but made alive by the Spirit." 1 Peter 3:8

Your task is to receive His gift of life!

"Yet to all who received him, to those who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God." John 1:12

"If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness." 1 John 1:19
