Cooking help is needed on **June 12** and **26**.

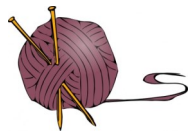

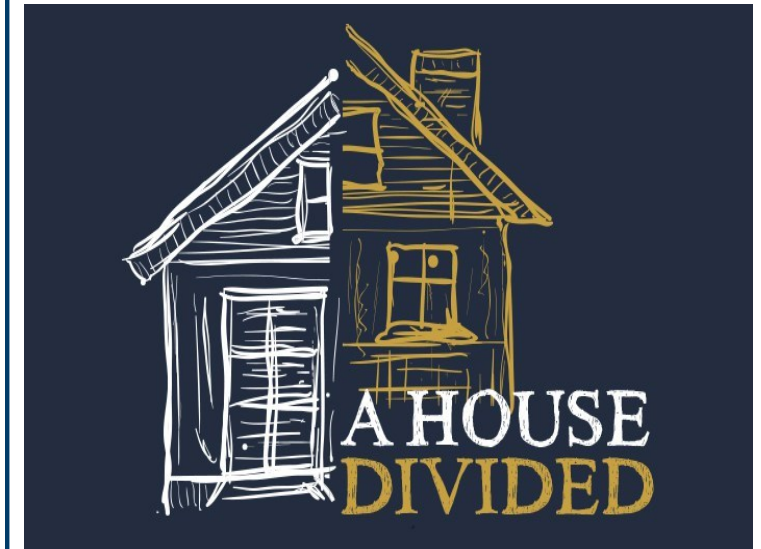
### Our Worship Services:
