NEW: School Receives Top Award Distinction

St. Paul's Lutheran School & ECC Earns Premier Parent Choice Award from ParentPulse

Throughout the 2024-25 school year, our parents at the ECC and K-8 school completed satisfaction surveys through a partner called ParentPulse. Their responses to "How likely are you to recommend us to a friend or colleague?" earned St. Paul's a Net Promoter Score (NPS) of 84! Each year ParentPulse awards schools that have an NPS of 80 or higher with the Premier Parent Choice Award. Fewer than 5 percent of ParentPulse partner schools received this distinction! According to ParentPulse, most organizations would be thrilled with an NPS of 30-50. Scores of 70+ are rare and considered world class.
