JOHN 1 In the beginning was the Word (Pre-Incarnate Christ), and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. ² He was in the beginning with God. ³ All things were made through him, and without him was not anything made that was made. ⁴ In him was life, and the life was the light of men. ⁵ The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it.

How Jesus appears

1. In Glory: **Daniel 10:5-6**; Revelation 1:12-18; Matt 17:1, Mark 9:2, Luke 9:28
2. As a Man: Genesis 18:2 (three men appear to Abraham)
Genesis 32:24 (a man who wrestles with Jacob at the River Jabbok)
3. As a Bush on Fire... Note who is the “I AM” ... LORD
4. As Water from a Rock “They all drank for the spiritual rock that followed them, and the Rock was Christ.” (I Corinthians 10:3)
5. A Top a Ladder “And he dreamed, and behold, there was a ladder set up on the earth, and the top of it reached to heaven. And behold, the angels of God were ascending and descending on it! ¹³ And behold, the LORD stood above it.” (Genesis 28:12-13)
6. One like the Son of God in the Fiery Furnace. Daniel 3:25
7. Angel of the Lord with his sword drawn Numbers 22:31 ... Balaam and his donkey
8. Commander of the Lord’s Army ... Joshua 5:13-15 ... “Take off your shoes, holy ground!”

How Jesus Describes Himself

Jesus said to them, “Truly, truly, I say to you, before Abraham was, I Am.” ⁵⁹ So they picked up stones to throw at him.” (John 8:58-59)

You will see greater things than these.” ⁵¹ And he said to him, “Truly, truly, I say to you, you will see heaven opened, and the angels of God ascending and descending on the Son of Man.” (John 1:50-51) ... (Remember Daniel 7:13)

“I Am” Statements:

- **I am the bread of life** (John 6:35): Jesus is the spiritual food that gives eternal life.
- **I am the light of the world** (John 8:12): Jesus provides spiritual guidance and leads people away from darkness.
- **I am the door of the sheep** (John 10:7, 9): Jesus is the only way to salvation and a relationship with God.
- **I am the good shepherd** (John 10:11, 14): Jesus is a protective leader who lays down his life for his followers.
- **I am the resurrection and the life** (John 11:25): Jesus has the power to bring the dead back to life and gives eternal life to those who believe in him.
- **I am the way and the truth and the life** (John 14:6): Jesus is the only path to God the Father.
- **I am the true vine** (John 15:1, 5): Jesus is the source of spiritual life for believers, who are like branches that bear fruit by staying connected to him.

How the Early Christians Described Christ (Kyrios = LORD in Greek O.T Septuagint)

“No one can say, ‘Jesus is (Kyrios/Lord) except by the Holy Spirit.” (I Corinthians 12:3)

“...to the only God, our Savior, through Jesus Christ our (Kyrios/ Lord), be glory, majesty, dominion, and authority, before all time and now and forever. Amen. (Jude 25)

“For we did not follow cleverly devised myths when we made known to you the power and coming of our (Kyrios/Lord) Jesus Christ, but we were eyewitnesses of his majesty.” (II Peter 1:16)
