Daniel's Prayer

The Context of Confession

Recognizing the Brokenness
Rooted in the Word
Found in Exile
(Re)turn to the Lord

The "We" of Sin

Daniel is included
We have sinned
We have not listened
All Refused to Obey the Lord's voice
Sin is never a "them" problem
God's Righteousness is Justice

The "We" of Dependence

Not in ourselves, but in God's great mercy
(v.18)
Going back to Exodus
Not just some, but all

The "We" of God's love

Put an end to sin
Brings everlasting righteousness
Restores
Requires Messiah

The Fulfillment of Daniel 9

The Anointed One Who Comes (v. 25)

The One Who Is "Cut Off" for the People (v. 26)

The One Who Confirms the Covenant (v. 27)

The One Who Brings Everlasting Righteousness (v. 24)

Daniel's vision spoke of the time when God would "finish transgression, put an end to sin, and bring in everlasting righteousness."

Christ's resurrection accomplishes this—sin's power is broken, and His righteousness becomes ours by faith.

What Daniel could only pray for, we now live in: a restored relationship with God grounded in mercy, not merit.
