Our YES (Fulfillment) and AMEN (Greater Fulfillment)!

Il Corinthians 1:20 For all the promises of God find their Yes in him. That is why it is through him that we utter our Amen to God for his glory.

"Pray Towards This Place"

Daniel prays TOWARDS and FOR God's Holy Hill! (Daniel 9:20)

YES: Hear the supplications of your servant and of your people Israel when they <u>pray toward this place</u>. Hear from heaven, your dwelling place; and when you hear, forgive. (II Chronicles 6:21)

- -When your people Israel have been defeated by an enemy because they have sinned. (6: 24)
- -When the heavens are shut up and there is no rain because your people have sinned against you (6:26)
- -For now I have chosen and consecrated this house that my name may be there <u>forever</u>. (7:16)

AMEN: ... most Holy Place. Know and understand this: From the time the word goes out to restore and rebuild Jerusalem <u>until the Anointed One, the ruler, comes...</u> (Daniel 9:24-25)

And the <u>Lord whom you seek will suddenly come to his temple</u>; the Messenger of the covenant in whom you delight. (Malachi 3:1)

"Very truly I tell you, my Father will give you whatever you ask in my name.." (John 14 23...spoken at the Temple)

"Finish Transgressions and Atone for Iniquities"

YES: Seventy weeks are decreed about your people and your holy city, to finish the transgression, to put an end to sin, and to atone for iniquity.

(Daniel 9:24)

AMEN: ... finish the transgression, to put an end to sin, and to atone for iniquity. (Daniel 9:24)

It is Finished. (John 19:30)

The death he died, He died for sin once for all. (Romans 6:10)

...a merciful and faithful high priest in the service of God, to make (Atonement) propitiation for the sins of the people. (Hebrews 2:17)

"He shall put an end to sacrifices and offering."

YES: Titus in 70 AD with the Destruction of the Temple and the Sacrifices and Offerings.

AMEN... But when Christ had offered for all time a single sacrifice for sins, he sat down at the right hand of God, (Hebrews 10:12)

Questions: At what point did the Father turn away? When was the Sacrifice Complete? How does this fit with the Apostles' Creed?
