



Q2 How often do you personally attend worship services in-person?







Q3 Which worship service(s) do you attend? Check all that apply.





Q4 Which worship service do you attend most often?





Q5 Please share your impressions of our church's online worship if you've experienced it?





Q6 How often do you attend Adult Sunday School or Bible Study (Sunday or during the week)?





Q7 How long in minutes would you typically say it takes you to get to church?





Q8 Which ministries have you participated in during the last five years? (select all that apply)









Q11 When I think about the size of our congregation...







Q13 Please rank the following six personality traits in order of importance for our new pastor, using a scale from 1 to 6, where 1 indicates the most important trait and 6 the least important.








Q16 Select the three purposes you consider most crucial for our church, in addition to worship and spiritual growth.






Q18 Thinking specifically about St. Paul's, choose up to five areas needing improvement with the congregation.


Q20 What do you most appreciate about your congregation? (Response optional)





Q25 What is your gender?



Q26 What is your religious background?




Q27 What is your membership status?
