

Creation inspired Apollo 8 astronauts

Dec. 24th (Christmas Eve) 1968

The Apollo 8 astronauts are the first to ever see the Earth's full majesty and beauty from space. They were so awestruck by the site that they felt moved to read a portion of the creation account from Genesis.

They were the first to see the entire Earth God created and could not pull their eyes away. They took the first ever photos of the Earth that appear in science books.

Communion on the Moon?



July 20th 1969

Shorty after Apollo 11 landed on the moon, something remarkable happened before Neil Armstrong made his famous footprint and "One Small Step for Man, One Giant Leap for Mankind" statement.

Astronaut Buzz Aldrin, a devout Christian, gave himself Holy Communion, on the moon.

This scene was a very private moment for him, witnessed only by Neil Armstrong. The event was portrayed in an HBO TV program called "From the Earth to the



The "Bulletproof" George Washington

George Washington's life was miraculously spared during the Battle of the Monongahela (PA) during the French and Indian War.



Battle of the Monongahela

July 9th 1755

Just outside of Pittsburgh PA.



British and Virginia MIlitia struggling against French soldiers and Indian warriors in the wilderness.

The British were trying to expel the French from Ft. Duquesne at the point where the Allegheny and Monongahela rivers meet to form the Ohio River. Present day Pittsburgh PA.

French and Indians ambushed the British forces and it was a major disaster for the British. Overall The British lost about 1000 men, the French lost only 90. The French and Indians also made it a point to intentionally target the officers on horseback. General James Braddock was killed along with three quarters of the officers killed or wounded. Washington was the ONLY house mounted officer not taken down by enemy fire!!


"The Long Island Fog"

In late August 1776, just a month or so after declaring Independence George Washington and his young inexperienced army were trapped on Long Island, New York. Defeated, surrounded and desperate, they tried to evacuate to Manhattan to survive. The evacuation was to be under cover of darkness, but it was delayed and soon morning would reveal the evacuation. Artillery and British navy ships would soon destroy the army, capture Washington, and our dreams of freedom and independence would be dead.

Then at dawn, came a mysterious dense fog came out of nowhere to conceal the evacuation. The entire remaining army made it safely to Manhattan and the struggle continued.



Pilgrims at Plymouth

The *Pilgrims* came to Plymouth MA in 1620. The first winter they nearly all died. They eventually flourished with the assistance of Native American like *Samoset* and Chief *Massasoit*. There was an Indian tribe living in the area that all died of disease brought by Europeans. The Pilgrims believed that God had cleared the land for them to live.

Samoset introduced the Pilgrims to the only survivor of that group of Indians. The young man's name was a *Tisquantum*, also known as *Squanto*. With his help and assistance, the Pilgrims survive and thrive, leading to the famous sharing of blessings at the first *Thanksgiving*.




Two Presidents die the same year ?- That's a coincidence

The Corps of Discovery never should have survived! Saved by Sacajawea, Baby (Pomp) and the Dog (Seaman) Saved by God's protection!






The "Amistad"


Abraham Lincoln




Reverend John Harper was lost but is remembered for his powerful Christian Witness.


F.D.R D-Day Prayer

Declaration of Independence




God is mentioned four times in the short Declaration.

Preamble- "And to assume among the powers of the earth the separate and equal station to which The Laws of nature and of **Nature's God** entitle them"

Famous phrase- "We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal, that they are endowed by their *Creator* with certain unalienable Rights that among these are Life, Liberty and the Pursuit of Happiness"



Declaration of Independence July 4, 1776



"We therefore, the representatives of the United States of America, in general Congress assembled, appealing to the **Supreme Judge of the world** for rectitude of our intentions...

"And for the support of this Declaration, with firm reliance on the protection of <u>divine Providence</u>, we mutually pledge to each other our Lives, our fortunes and our sacred Honor."

When reflecting on the foiling of the plot of Benedict Arnold...






- 1) The protective care of God

Hancock- President of the Continental Congress and famous signer of the Declaration of Independence.
