# Packing for Camp

You must pack all your things in ONE suitcase and ONE small carry-on bag.

### What to Bring

- Sack Lunch for Monday We will stop to eat at a rest stop.
- Bible and Pen (we know that many of you use the Bible on your phone but for this week we ask that you bring a physical Bible. We will provide a booklet for notes)
- Sheets/blanket or sleeping bag, pillow (no bedding is provided)
- Modest Casual Clothes for 5 days (no spagnetti straps, backless tops, short shorts etc.)
- Modest ONE-piece bathing suit (see camp rules)
- Beach towel, sunglasses, and SUNSCREEN
- Bath towel and toiletries (nothing is provided except toilet paper)
- Jacket or sweater just in case it gets a little cool at night
- Money for lunch and dinner on Friday, for snacks at the Snack Shack, and if you want any souvenirs
- Reusable Water bottle (we will have water cools pool side to allow you to refill and stay hydrated)
- We are planning to have a theme night each week after the evening worship service so bring items for the following theme nights.
  - Tacky Tourist
  - Squad Night (Dress up together with one or more friends, you pick the theme: Star Wars Characters, 80's rock band, High School Musical, etc.
  - o **Leader look-a-like** (Dress up like any one of your youth leaders, band leaders, or pastor)
  - Puns (Just google pun costumes- you'll get the idea. This will be a lot of fun.)

**NOTE**-NHBC is not responsible for any student property that gets lost, stolen or damaged. Please leave any unnecessary valuable items at home.

### What NOT to Bring

- Laptops, tablets or other electronic devices other than your phone. (We don't want these valuables to get lost or damaged plus we also don't want them to be a distraction for you.)
- Water balloons (The camp has a no-water-balloon policy)
- Weapons (leave your pocket knives at home; if we see them they will be taken up)
- Fireworks
- Items for pranking

### General details

- We will be leaving the Church on Monday June 19th at 6am so we can catch the bus in Atlanta by 8. That means you will need to be here and checked in before that!
- Buses will depart 1st Baptist Douglasville at 9:00am, so we have to be there early to load up our bags and check in.
- We will return to the Church at approximately 10:00pm on Friday June 23rd.

## For Parents

- Please be in prayer for your student and the rest of the students and leaders this week.

- If you are dropping off and picking up please have the students there on time and picked up on time. Our arrival time may vary so we will have students call or text when we are about 30 mins away.

# Camp Rules

- 1. Honor Christ everything else flows out of this.
- 2. Respect others just remember the golden rule on this one
- 3. Respect property pick up your trash and don't do anything that would cause damage to or mess-up any Laguna Beach property or others possessions.
- 4. NO weapons, NO profanity, NO drugs or alcohol, NO tobacco, NO fireworks, NO fighting, NO stealing, NO water balloons, NO sneaking out after curfew
- 5. You may have your phone but please limit your use on them during the week and leave them in your room during the worship services, small group meetings and quiet times. If we see you on them during these times we will take them up.
- 6. Do not leave the grounds for any reason. Grounds include: Bethany pool and dorm area, Snack Shack, basketball courts, and beach directly across the street from dorms.
- 7. If you choose to go down to the Snack Shack or to the beach be sure that your leader knows and that you go with a friend. As a general rule, don't go anywhere (except to the bathroom) by yourself.
- 8. Please report any injuries or sickness to a leader or nurse.
- 9. No guys allowed in the girls' rooms no girls allowed in guys' rooms... EVER. All the girls' rooms are on the second floor, so the only time a guys should even be upstairs is when he is in the large meeting room.
- 10. Students and leaders are to observe and attend all sessions, services, and devotion times.
- 11. No one allowed outside of basketball courts or pool and dorm area after dark. That means after dark do not go to the beach or the Snack Shack without being accompanied by an adult.
- 12. Everyone is to be pool side or in their rooms by 11:30pm. Everyone is to be in their rooms by 12:00am.
- 13. No joining any other group for their activities. If anyone from another group wishes to join us for our activities they must have written permission from their youth leader and permission from Phillip or Jamie.
- 14. Girls wear modest one-piece suits or a dark t-shirt over suit. You are allowed to wear a tankini, however, the top should touch the bottom all the way around.
- 15. Guys no speedos (that just ain't right) and keep pants/shorts/swim suits pulled up to your waist.
- 16. Couples no public display of affection (PDA). This includes but not limited to kissing, forms of cuddling, and any action sexual in nature.
