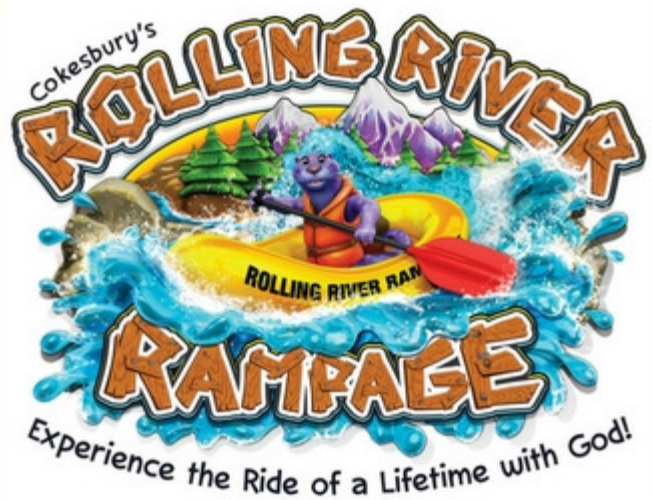

The **Prelude** is one of eight "little" teaching pieces attributed to Johann Sebastian Bach (1685-1750) but probably written by one of his talented pupils. The reflective **Offertory** was penned in 1986 by David Evans. The **Postlude** will no doubt be familiar to many; it is from a collection of keyboard pieces compiled around 1722 by Bach for his musical wife Anna Magdalena.
