Music Notes

The **Prelude** was published in 1710 by Louis-Nicholas Clérambault, a musician at the Parisian church of St. Sulpice and one of France's finest Baroque organists. Gospel songs, such as the **anthem**, *Steal Away* encourage faith and perseverance in hard times. The graceful **Offertory** was composed in Cöthen, Germany circa 1717-20 by Johann Sebastian Bach; an *allemande* or "German" dance begins on an upbeat and features quietly flowing sixteenth notes. The **Postlude** is a march by Maurice Greene (1696-1755), English court composer to King George II.
