1. **Vision Team** - Create a vision for Trinity's ministries. Design a volunteer recruiting and membership training event.
2. **Vision Fundraising Team (VFT)** - Develop a kick-off sermon series; launch a fall Stewardship Campaign; plan and execute a Capital Campaign.
3. **Hospitality - Communication Connection Team (CCT)** - Develop a comprehensive plan to improve our hospitality. CCT with the Staff will create a **Worship Planning Team (WPT)** to connect Trinity's worship to the community.
4. **Discipleship** - Create a pilot program of small groups that can begin to pursue a deeper spiritual life together.
