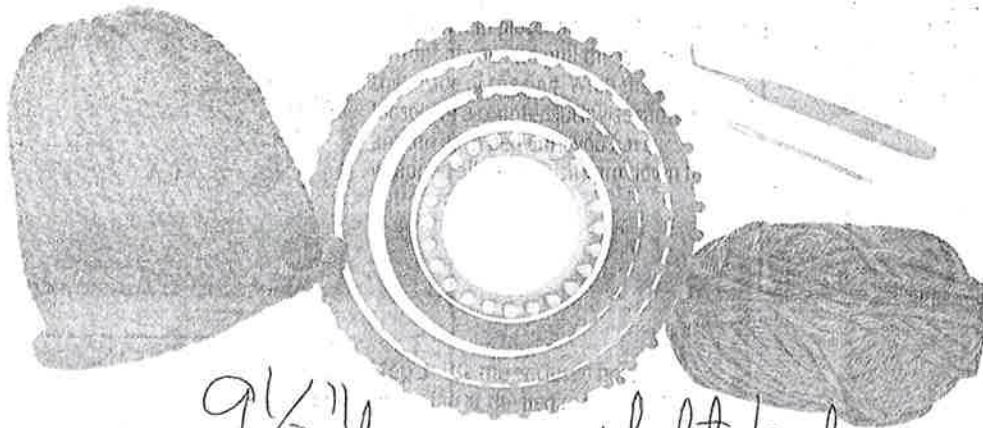


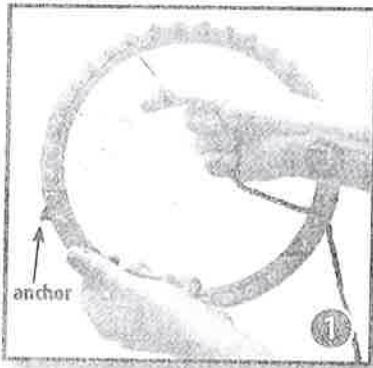
KNITTING INSTRUCTIONS FOR ROUND LOOM



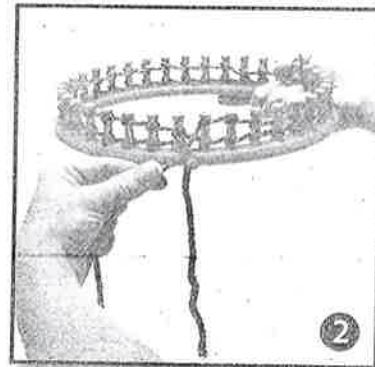
- For best results, use bulky weight yarn or 2 strands of worsted weight yarn held together.
- You will need 1-2 skeins of yarn, depending on yardage and desired hat size.
- Hook and yarn needle included.
- The green loom makes a small hat (babies), purple makes a medium hat (children), orange makes a large hat, and pink makes an extra large hat.

9 1/2" loom for adult hat.
To Make a Hat

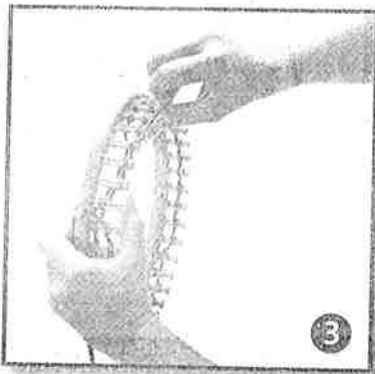
5.75" loom for toby hat.



Step 1: Wrap the yarn around the anchor peg on the side of the loom to fasten it in place. Hold the loom in front of you and pull the yarn to the inside of the ring. Wrap the yarn loosely in a counterclockwise motion around each peg until you have wrapped all pegs. Push yarn down to bottom of pegs.



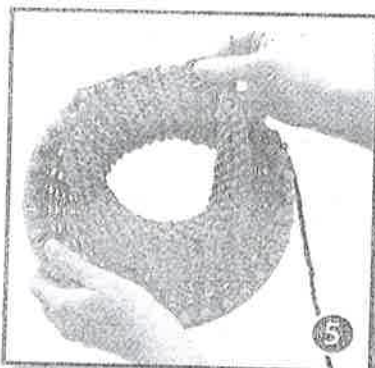
Step 2: Continue to wrap the yarn around each peg again so that you have 2 rows of yarn on the loom. Wrap the end of the yarn around the anchor peg to secure while knitting.



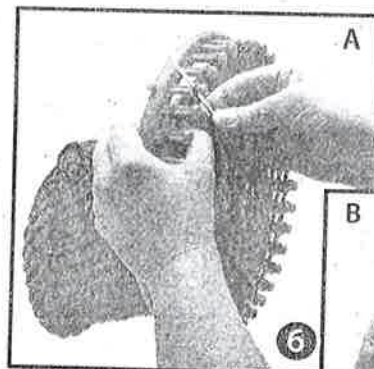
Step 3: Use the enclosed hook, beginning at the peg to the right of the anchor peg. Lift the bottom row of yarn over the top of the peg. Continue in a clockwise direction around the loom until you have only one loop remaining on each peg. Release the yarn wrapped on the anchor peg.

** Step 4:* Repeat steps 2-3 until hat reaches the desired size. A small hat will measure 7", medium 8", and large or extra large 9". If you are adding a brim to the hat (which will help keep the bottom from rolling up), see the measurements in step 5.

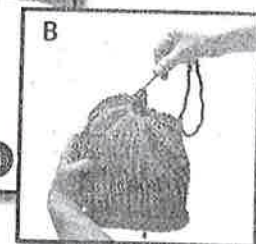
** Brim is not recommended*



Step 5: To add a brim to your hat, knit 3" for small, 4" for medium, and 5" for a large hat. You should have only 1 row of loops on your loom. Reach inside the loom and fold the bottom of the hat back up to the pegs. Being careful to line up rows, place each loop from the bottom row over the corresponding peg. This folds the knitted portion into the brim, and you will now have 2 loops on each peg. Knit this row by pulling the bottom loop over each peg. Repeat steps 2-3 until hat reaches the appropriate overall length for its size.



Step 6: Finishing the hat: Cut yarn about 18" from the hat. Thread yarn through enclosed craft needle. Beginning at first peg, run the needle through the loop, and lift off peg. (A)



Continue around the loom lifting each loop off pegs while threading. Pull the thread tight and tie off with a square knot to secure. (B)
