The Season of Perpetual Hope

Some hope that the Christmas season will mend a broken relationship. Why now? Well, 'tis the season of perpetual hope! But when things don't work out the way you wanted, does it leave you feeling hopeless? Then I have glad tidings for you. Your life in Christ is anything but hopeless.

Did you know that Advent is also known as the "season of perpetual hope?" Jesus, the promised Christ, gives unfading hope. Christ has died. Christ is risen. Christ will come again! Because Jesus has ransomed you and me from our sins, we have the hope of eternal life! This hope cannot be lost. IRA Charitable Giving

One great thing that has resulted from the "Big Beautiful Bill" passed by Congress this year is the establishment of the Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) rule. The IRS now allows taxpayers 70 ½ and older to transfer funds directly from their IRA to a qualified 501(c)(3) charity like our church. With a normal charitable contribution, you donate first, keep records of your gifting and then take a deduction on taxes later, but only if you itemize. A QCD, however, never counts as income because they are never deposited into your personal bank account.

Donating through a QDC counts toward your Required Minimum Distribution and is excluded from your income for tax purposes. This helps to reduce your tax bracket and minimize Medicare premium increases, Net Investment Taxes, and Taxes on Social Security benefits. QCD's must be made from private IRA's. Employer sponsored 401(k)'s, such as the Federal TSP, do not qualify. Instead, you would need to withdraw funds from those accounts and set up an IRA for a future QCD. Those withdraws are considered income, so be careful not to move too much annually. If you are interested, please contact your financial advisor for complete details.
