Quality programs start with quality coaches. The Academy expects coaches to act as Christian role models and be Christ-like ambassadors for the school. Coaches should be committed to fulfilling the mission of the school, helping students grow in their relationship with God and their sport, and have a deep passion and knowledge of their sport.

In addition, Academy coaches and assistant coaches must:

- Value every player – independent of their ability – as God’s image bearer
- Show respect and grace towards officials and opposing players and coaches
- Allot playing time at their discretion
- Schedule, plan and run practices
- Collect and maintain appropriate paperwork, forms and fees (physicals, waivers, etc)
- Serve as liaison between school and practice and/or playing facility
- Provide clear, consistent communication to players and families regarding practice and game schedule as well as other team matters
- Check uniforms in and out from students
- Manage plays, strategies, playing time during games all in an effort to both compete well and cultivate virtue in players
- Maintain humility in victory and defeat
