The community in Colmini is nestled among the cactus in the desert. Colmini has many needs, and one of those is a place for children to meet for school. The teachers hang sheets to separate the classes inside the church. This keeps the kids a little bit less distracted, but without paper and pens, children in Haiti learn by repetition. Imagine repeating after your teacher and hearing the next class doing the same. A new building has begun! In this case the rebar is reaching towards the sky waiting for completion.



Charette

Charette is located in the hills outside St. Marc. The church stood firm while some people said that God was dead there. The now thriving church and school (360 children) has two buildings.
