## Property Work Day

Saturday, September 12th 8:00am-4:00pm

This is an amazing opportunity to show kids the importance of working with others to accomplish a goal for someone else. We often see kids get stuck in a rut of doing something because it benefits them, but not going out of their comfort zone to help others. This can help teach them that doing something for the glory of God is worth doing well!

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# To know when coming in:

-All students will be dropped off at the beginning of the church service, instead of 1<sup>st</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> grade sitting upstairs in the sanctuary and then coming down stairs.

-We will be using a one direction flow in the children's wing, because of the tightness of the hallways. Enter through the Children's wing doors by the back parking lot, after dropping off your child(ren) go up the stairs into the front lobby. When coming back down to pick up your children, head to the front of the sanctuary. There are two sets of stairs for the parent picking up, to come down. They will again follow the one direction of flow to the stairs into the front lobby.

-As always, parents will stay in the hallways when picking up their child(ren)

-All children must be picked up from the classroom after each service is done.(this includes children of those who serve in worship, greeting, children's ministry, ect.)

-Temperature checks will be done at the half wall by the children's wing.

-Fask masks will be worn by the nursery-pre k teachers because the teachers are not able to teach, comfort, and assist these age groups while maintaining social distancing standards.

-Face masks can be worn by students, but are not required.

-First service is 8:45am for first service again!
