“AN EVIL REPORT?”

(Numbers 13:23)

“So those men gave a report that **discouraged** the people.” (ERV)

“So the report of those other scouts was quiet **disheartening**; *it make the people question God’s promise.*” (VOC)

“So the majority report of the spies was **negative**.” (TLB)

1. REVIEW:

- The Lord said to Moses, “Send 12 spies to explore and scout [to examine, inspect, or observe for the purpose of obtaining information] out [for yourselves] the land of Canaan,…” (Num. 13:1-2)
- The thrill of this wilderness camping experience has worn off, and some are thinking that working for the Egyptians wasn’t so bad. So barely two years out of Egypt, the Israelites are standing at the door of their promised land. Moses needs to motivate the people, and he selects 12 key men from each of the tribes to explore the land of abundance God has provided. The nation stands to enter into a time of great reward, but first their leaders must bring back a report that will inspire their confidence. Pick one man, with demonstrated leadership, from each of tribal families.

2. THE EXPLORATION OF THE LAND:

- Moses sent 12 spies to explore the land of Canaan and said to them to tell us about the land and its people:
 - Are they strong or weak?
 - Are there a lot of them or only a few?
 - Do their cities have fortifications?
 - Are their camps open all around?
 - Is the land itself good or bad?
 - Is the land soil rich or poor?
 - Are there any trees?
- Be BOLD, and bring back samples of what grows there like their grapes. And they checked out the lush Eshcol [cluster of grapes] riverbed that, as its name suggests, grew bunches of grapes. **SO THICK** and **HEAVY WERE CLUSTERS** that when two of the men cut down one branch holding one cluster [blessing], they had to carry it on a pole between them. They also picked up some pomegranates [healing] and figs [curses] from that place.

3. AFTER 40 DAYS THE SPIES RETURNED AND REPORTED TO ISRAELITES.

- ...they brought them ‘word’, and showed them the land’s **FRUIT**. (Num. 13:25, 27)
- Proverbs 18:21 NiRV: “Your tongue has the power of life and death. Those who love to talk will eat the fruit of their words.” Other is “Your words are so

WEIGHTY that they have power to bring life or death, and the talkative person will reap the consequences.” (TPT)

- They told Moses, ‘We came to the land to which you send us; **SURELY IT FLOWS WITH MILK AND HONEY**. That is its fruit.” (Num. 13:27)
4. **THE WRONG CONFESSION _____ THE FIRST.**
- **BUT** the people who dwell there are **STRONG**, and the cities are **FORTIFIED** and **VERY LARGE**, moreover, there we saw the sons of Anak [of great stature and courage]. (Num. 13:28)
5. **EVERY PERSON WHO WALKS BY FAITH WILL HAVE _____.**
- Caleb quieted the people before, and **SAID**, “Let us go up at once and possess it; **WE ARE WELL ABLE TO CONQUER IT.**” (Num. 13:30)
6. **THE CONFESSION OF SATAN’S ABILITY TO _____ YOU AND KEEP YOU FROM _____, GIVE SATAN DOMINION OVER YOU AND FILLS YOU WITH FEAR AND WEAKNESS.**
- **BUT** the ten spies said, “No way. **WE CAN’T DO IT**. The people who are already there are too strong for us. So the report of these other spies was quite disheartening; it made the people question God’s promise. The land that we surveyed virtually eats its own, and the people themselves are gigantic. We saw the massive Anakites who descended from the ancient Nephilim! We look like **GRASSHOPPERS** compared to them, and they know it.” (Num. 13:31-33)
7. **MOST OF THE CONFESSIONS THAT WE HEAR TODAY GLORIFY THE _____ . IT DESTROYS FAITH AND HOLDS YOU IN BONDAGE.**
- And all the Israelite congregation **GRUMBLED** and **DEPLORED** [to regret deeply, lament, disapprove] their situations, accusing Moses and Aaron, to whom the whole congregation **SAID**; (Num. 14:2-4)
 - Would that we had died in Egypt?
 - Or that we had died in this wilderness!
 - Why does the Lord bring us to this land to fall by the sword?
 - Our wives and little ones will be a prey.
 - Is it not better for us to return to Egypt?
 - Let us choose a captain and return to Egypt.
8. **OUR FAITH OR UNBELIEF IS _____ BY OUR CONFESSION.**
- ‘How many times will these bad people grumble against Me and My choice? It seems that all I hear is Israelites complaining, complaining, complaining! So tell them I say, “As I live, says the Lord, what you **HAVE SAID** in My hearing **I WILL DO TO YOU**”.’ (Num. 14:27-34)
9. **YOU ARE STUDY THE WORD UNTIL YOU KNOW WHAT ARE YOUR RIGHTS ARE, AND THEN HOLD FAST TO THEM** (God’s Word). Your confidence is in that unbroken, living Word, and you hold fast to your confession in the face of every _____ of the enemy.
