
CDC offers 3 new classes for **SPRING 2016**

TODAY OF HEALING WORD

Psalms 107:20: "He sent His Word, and healed them, and delivered them from their destructions."

How did God send His Word to heal us? He gave us 66 books of His Words—the Bible. As we hear the Word, it starts working inside us to make us completely healed and whole.

When you go all through the Gospels, in most cases you'll find that hearing came before healing. And if it worked that way under Jesus' ministry, it still works that way today.

When you need healing, the best thing you can do is to hear and hear and hear and hear. Keep God's Word going into your ears every way possible. Keep hearing what God says about your healing.

Many people want to go to one particular meeting and miraculously receive healing; they aren't interested in hearing. Sometimes God in His mercy does manifest Himself, and people receive their healing. But most of the time, they have to take time to hear before they are healed.

You see, walking by faith doesn't come from leaving your Bible on the shelf until it's time to dust it off and carry it to the church. Faith comes as you get into God's Word. It builds in your spirit as you hear it from the preacher, from teaching tapes and DVDs, and especially from out of your own mouth.

God sent His Word, and it heals you. When does it heal you? When you take the time to hear it.

CONFESSION: God sent His Word to heal me, and His Word is life and medicine to all my flesh. I hear His Word and obey it, and I'm delivered from sickness and disease. Amen.

“PENI-EL”

(Genesis 32:24-31)

And Jacob called the name of the place ‘PENI-EL’; for I have seen God face to face, and my life is preserved. (v. 30)

1. The Hebrew word ‘PENI-EL’: ‘PENI’ [or PANA] means ‘_____’; ‘EL’ means ‘_____’. Put it together: face God, the face of God, God’s face.
2. Jacob experienced the supernatural encounter with God.
3. Let us examine and review Jacob’s natural and spiritual journey:
 - a) His father is Isaac. His mother is Rebekah. (Gen. 24:67)
 - b) Both parents expected twin babies. (Gen. 25:22)
 - c) Esau, first son born. He is a hairy man, a skillful hunter, a man of field. (Gen. 25:25, 27)
 - d) Jacob, second son born. He is a quiet man, living in tents, and cooking foods at home. (Gen. 25:26, 27, 29)
 - e) At the age of _____, Isaac became a father of both boys. (Gen. 25:26)
The number represents ‘_____’.
 - f) Why? Isaac loved Esau. Rebekah loved Jacob. (Gen. 25:28)
 - g) BIRTHRIGHT belongs to which: Esau or Jacob
 - h) Isaac was old and his eyes were dim, so that he could not see...said to Esau, “make me savor food, such as I love, and bring it to me, that I may eat; that my soul bless you before I die.” (Gen. 27:1-4)
 - i) Rebekah HEARD when Isaac spoke to Esau...
 - ☞ Rebekah REMEMBERED what the Lord prophesied, “Two nations are in your womb, and two kinds of people shall be born of you; and the one people shall be stronger than the other people; and the elder shall serve the younger.” (Gen. 25:23)
 - j) ABRAHAM’S BLESSING belongs to which: Esau or Jacob
 - k) Esau told his father, “Jacob” is certainly the right name for him! He has once again grabbed me by the heels! He has deceived me now two times. He took away my birthright, and now he has taken away my blessing! Have you no blessing reserved for me as well? (Gen. 27:36)
 - ☞ His brother followed with his hand clutching Esau’s heel, so they named him ‘Jacob’. (Gen. 25:26)
 - ☞ Hosea 12:3 prophesied, “Even from the womb, he [Jacob] fought with his brother [Esau] by grabbing his heel; when he grew to be an adult, he struggled against God.”

- l) Esau hated Jacob, purposing to kill him. (Gen. 27:41-42) Esau saw that Isaac had blessed Jacob. (Gen. 28:6) Jacob obeyed his parents. (Gen. 28:7) Esau seeing that the daughters of Canaan not pleased Isaac, his father. (Gen. 28:8)
- m) Jacob went to Rebekah's family in Syria. Jacob married 4 wives: Leah (weary), Rachel (ewe), Bilhah (tender), and Zilpah (a dropping).
- n) Jacob's children: 1. Reuben 2. Simeon 3. Levi 4. Judah 5. Dan 6. Naphtali 7. Gad 8. Asher 9. Issachar 10. Zebulum 11. Joseph 12. Benjamin
- o) Jacob told Laban, father-in-law, "Thus have I been 20 years in your house; I served you 14 years for your 2 daughters, and 6 years for your cattle: and you have changed my wages 10 times." (Gen. 32:41)
4. Y N NS: Is Jacob an ordinary guy like you?
5. Jacob—his first encountering with God through _____. (Gen. 28:11-22) God talked to Jacob in the dream.
6. Y N NS: Can God talk to you in your dream?
7. Jacob and family went on way and the angels met him. Jacob saw them and said, "This is God's host: and he called them the name of that place 'Mahanaim' means 'God's two camps'. Jacob's encountering with angels. (Gen. 32:1-2)
8. Y N NS: Should you also see and encounter the angels of God?
9. Jacob received the message from his servant that his brother and 400 men will come to see him...Jacob was greatly _____ and _____...(Gen. 32:6-7)
10. Jacob REHEARSED and SAID, "O' God of my father Abraham, and God of my father Isaac, the Lord which said to me, 'Return to your country, and to your family, and I will deal well with you.'" (Gen. 32:9-12)
11. Interesting...And Jacob rose up that night, and took his two wives, and his two women-servants, and his eleven sons, and passed over the ford 'Jabbok'. And he took them, and sent them over the brook, and sent over that he had. And Jacob was left alone; and there wrestled a man with him until the breaking of the day. (Gen. 32:21-24) 'Jabbok' means '_____'.
12. Jacob's name changed to 'Israel' which means "God prevails or rules'. (Gen. 32:28)
13. Jacob's encountering with God...God _____ to Jacob, 'Arise, go up to Bethel, and live there...' (Gen. 35:1) Jacob HEARD what God has said.
14. Y N NS: Have you obey what God is saying to you?
15. Interesting here: Jacob told to his household, and to all that were with him, "Put away the strange gods that are among you, and be clean, and change your garments"....and they journeyed: and the terror of God was upon the cities that were round them, and they did not pursue after the sons of Jacob. (Gen. 35:1-5) Save it this story to next Sunday!
