SUNDAY MORNING WITH THE HOLY SPIRIT

BE QUICK TO FORGIVE

WHEN YOU ARE angry and frustrated. you have to ask yourself an honest question: Have you let resentment build up in your heart? Unless you are intentional about forgiving-and are forgive-a residue auick to resentment will build up over your heart the way dirt builds up on a windshield. Over time it will sink down into your heart and form a root of bitterness. Anger and frustration are often rooted in a failure to forgive the little annoyances as they occur. Eventually, the resentment pot boils over. Be guick to forgive-every time you get slightly annoyed. Be guick to forgive. (Hebrews 12:15; Colossians 3:13; 1 Corinthians 13:4-7)

PRAYER: Show me any resentment, bitterness, or unforgiveness in my heart. I don't want any part of it. I choose to forgive, and I renounce wrong thoughts and emotions that are standing against Your command to forgive in Jesus' Name. Amen.

FOCUS ON WHO YOU ARE IN CHRIST

YOU ARE a new creation in Christ. You are defined by what Christ did on the Cross—you are saved, healed, delivered, and prosperous in Him. The enemy will put up smoke and mirrors to distract you from this reality. He doesn't want you to know who you really are. He doesn't want you to know who Jesus really is. He wants you to focus on his evil instead of Father's good.

Stay focused on Jesus, who you are in Him, and who He is in you, and you won't fall for the enemy's devices. The revelation of Jesus and who you are in Him is something that will grow deeper

and deeper and deeper the more you meditate on Him. (2 Corinthians 5:17; Isaiah 54:14; 1 John 4:4)

■ The word 'obey' means 'to hear, to listen, to hear with attention or interest, to understand (language).
✓ My charge
The word 'kept' (shamar) means "to keep, to guard, to observe to give heed, to protect, to save life, to wait for, to treasure u (in memory), to keep (within bounds), to restrain, to abstair to celebrate".
The word 'charge' (mishmehreth) means "guard, function obligation, service, watch, office".
My commandments (mitsvah) means "law ordinances, precept".
✓ My statues (chuqqah) means "custom, appointed
manners, rites".
✓ My laws (torah) means "law direction
instruction hody of prophetic teaching"

- 2. What we learn from last week:
 - "13" means "depravity and rebellion".
 - Romans 8:7 TPT: "In fact, the mind-set focused on the flesh fight God's plan and refuses to submit to His direction, because it cannot!"
 - "26" means "the Gospel of Christ Jesus". Romans 1:16-"...for the Gospel of Christ is the POWER of God unto salvation to everyone who believes..."
 - "5" means "the grace or goodness of God". Ephesians 2:8– "For by grace you are saved through faith; and that not of yourselves..."

Romans 4:13 NLT: "Clearly, God's Promise to give the whole earth to Abraham and his descendants (seed) was based not on his obedience to God's law, but on a right relationship (righteousness) with God that comes by FAITH."

Romans 4:16 TPT: "The Promise depends on faith so that it can be experienced as a grace-gift, and now it extends to all the descendants of Abraham. This Promise is not only meant for those who obey the law, but also to those who enter into the faith of Abraham, the father of us all."

Romans 4:17: "That's what the Scripture means when it says: The Lord said, "I have made you the father of many nations." He is our example and father, for in God's presence he believe that God can raise the dead and call into being things that don't even exist yet"."

Romans 4:20-21: He never stopped believing God's Promise, for he was made strong in his faith 'to father a child'. And because he was mighty in faith and convinced that God had all the power needed to fulfill His promises, Abraham glorified God!

Romans 4:22: "So now you can see why Abraham's faith was credited to his account as righteousness before God."

Romans 4:23-24: "And this declaration was not just spoken over Abraham, but also over us. For when we believe and embrace the One who brought our Lord Jesus back to life, perfect righteousness will credited to our account as well.

Romans 4:25: "Jesus handed over to be crucified for the forgiveness of our sins and was raised back to life to prove that He had made us right with God."
