DAY OF HEALING

“Don’t just listen—HEAR”

And it came to pass on a certain day, as He was teaching, that there were Pharisees and doctors of the law sitting by, which were come out of every town of Galilee, and Judea, and Jerusalem: and the power of the Lord was present to heal them. (Luke 5:17)

The power of the Lord was present to heal the Pharisees and doctors of the law, but not one of them was healed. The Bible says Jesus was teaching, but how many present were actually hearing?

Someone may say, “Well, all of them must have been hearing: they were sitting right there in the same room with Jesus.”

Not necessarily so! Did you know you can be listening without hearing? I know that from experience. I’ve been in numerous conversations with my wife, Janet, where she suddenly stopped talking and said, “Mark, you haven’t heard a word I’ve said.”

“I’ve been listening!” I always protest. But then I think, ‘Have I really been listening?’ Although I can remember what Janet said five minutes earlier, my mind has been on something else. I’ve been listening; I know she’s been talking, but I didn’t hear what she said. So yes, it’s possible to listen and still not hear a thing.

Yet the Bible never said a word about the scribes, Pharisees, and doctors of the law hearing. In fact, those religious leaders weren’t listening to accuse Jesus. Despite their wrong reason, God still sent His power to heal them. All they had to do was receive by faith.

CONFESSION: I don’t just listen; I hear the Word of God concerning healing.

Then faith rises up in my heart to receive, and I’m healed.

"The Holiness of God"

One of His Attributes (PT 2)

"CELEBRATING THE (Isaiah 6:1) SUPREMACY OF CHRIST"

v. 1- "In the year that King Uzziah died, [in a vision] I saw the Lord sitting upon a throne, *high and lifted up*, and the skirts of His train filled the [most holy part of the] Temple."

1. Today: As we look at the awesome holiness of God,

- What should our response be?
- How should we prepare ourselves to meet with a holy God?

v. 5- "...my eyes have seen the King, the LORD Almighty."

2. This exercise is designed to help you apply a right response to God's holiness. There are several responses:

- **AWESOME and WONDER:** Whatever God's presence is felt, we encounter the wonder and mystery of His holiness. "*How awesome is the LORD Most High, the great King over all the earth!*" (Ps. 47:2)
- **SEEKING GOD'S PRESENCE:** When we encounter a holy God, it causes us to become hungry for His presence. We are willing to sacrifice our time so we can seek Him more. "*Look to the LORD and His strength; seek His face [presence] always.*" (Ps. 105:4)
- **PRAISE and WORSHIP:** Our lives take on a greater dimension of praise and worship. We begin to thank Him for the little details in our lives. We begin to let worship permeate our lives all day. "*Ascribe to the Lord the glory due His Name; worship the LORD in the splendor of His holiness.*" (Ps. 29:2)

3. What happened to King Uzziah? _____

4. Who was King Uzziah?

- Uzziah was the son of Amaziah. At age of 16, he became the king of Judah. He reigned for 52 years. (2 Chron. 26:1, 3)
- Uzziah did that which was right in the sight of the Lord. He sought God in the days of Zechariah, who had understanding in the visions of God; and as long as he sought the Lord, God made him prosper. (2 Chron. 26:4-5)
- Uzziah was the man of war. (2 Chron. 26:6)
- But when King Uzziah was strong, he became _____ to his destruction; and he trespassed against the LORD his God, for he went into the temple of the Lord to burn incense on the altar of incense. (2 Chron. 26:16)
- And Azariah the priest went in after him and with him 80 priests of the Lord, men of courage. They opposed King Uzziah and said to him, "It is not for you, Uzziah, to burn incense to the Lord, but for the priests, the sons of

Aaron, who are set apart to burn incense. Withdraw from the sanctuary; you have trespassed, and that will not be your credit and honor before the LORD God. Then Uzziah was _____, and he had a censer in his hand to burn incense. And while he was enraged with the priests, _____ broke out on his forehead before the priests in the house of the Lord, beside the incense altar. (2 Chron. 26:17-19)

- And King was a leper to the day of his death, and, being a leper, he dwelt in a separate house, for he was excluded [cut off] from the Lord's house. (2 Chron. 26:21)
- "Uzziah" means: _____
- Jeremiah 17:5 ERV: This is what the LORD says: "Bad things [curse] will happen to those who put their trust in people. Bad things [curse] will happen to those who depend on human strength. This is because they have stopped trusting the Lord."

Colossians 1:15-18 NLT: "Christ is the visible image of the invisible God. He existed before anything was created and is supreme over all creation, for through Him God created everything in the heavenly realms and on earth. He made the things we can see and things we can't see—such as thrones, kingdoms, rulers, and authorities in the unseen world. Everything was created through Him and for Him. He existed before anything else, and He holds all creation together. Christ is the Head of the church, which is His body. He is the beginning, supreme over all who rise from the dead. So He is first in everything."

5. The truth is that Jesus Christ is our one thing; He is everything. We must keep this continually before us on a daily basis: "You are my One Thing. You are my All!"

Hebrews 12:2 AMP: "[looking away from all that will distract us and] focusing our eyes on Jesus, who is the Author and Perfector of faith..."

6. Fixing your eyes on Jesus is the greatest holiness. Holiness is a by-product of 'seeing' Jesus in His grace. When you see Jesus and receive His love and grace everyday, your heart is transformed inwardly.

7. When we fix our eyes on Jesus and make Him the center of our lives, we will be transformed supernaturally and walk above the churning waters of guilt and condemnation. However, when we turn our eyes away from Jesus and start to look again at the waves of our failures, mistakes, and sins, we will, like Peter, begin to sink into the raging tempest of guilt and condemnation. Today is the day of your breakthrough. Learn to see what God sees by fixing your eyes on Jesus. You need to understand that what you see or how others see you is NOT AS IMPORTANT AS HOW GOD SEES YOU.

8. THE LIFE APPLICATION: This week each individual write a prayer, celebrating the supremacy of Jesus Christ in your personal life with the Scriptures above and mediating and take time to comment to the Lord.
