DAY OF HEALING

“Act on God’s Word!”

STOP TRYING to make God’s Word work and **start acting on the Word.**

Let me share with you the testimony of A.B. Simpson. He just acted like the Word is true and received his healing. I read his testimony years ago in a Christian magazine. Dr. Simpson, a Presbyterian minister at the time of his healing later founded the Christian and Missionary Alliance. At the age of 46, he was told he was dying of a heart condition and was given only about 6 months to live.

Dr. Simpson said he had heard many testimonies of healing, even in his own church. He took a short leave of absence and went up to his farm, where he could spend a lot of time studying God’s Word.

At the end of 2 weeks, Dr. Simpson took a piece of paper and a pencil and wrote, “After searching the Word of God for 2 weeks, I am convinced the Bible teaches that divine healing is for us today. And I, this day, **accept Jesus Christ as my Healer** and declare that I am now healed from heart trouble and that I am well. And I promise God to use this new-found strength and life and energy entirely for His purpose and to further the Gospel. I promise God I will share this truth of healing with others and will help them.

After that time, Dr. Simpson went to a luncheon where he was to be the speaker. At the gathering he gave his testimony that he had searched the Bible and concluded that Jesus was still the Healer today. After the luncheon, he was invited to go mountain, climbing by the men to whom he had spoken. The thought immediately came to him that he wouldn’t be able to go because of

his heart condition. But then he remembered he had declared his healing, so he accepted the invitation. Up to this point, he had not really seen or felt his healing—he had just accepted it and declared it by faith.

As he climbed, **every time he got his mind off the Word of God, he would begin to feel the symptoms of his heart condition.** But as he claimed the Word again for his healing, all the symptoms would go away. He fought this battle all the way up the mountain. Once at the top, he walked about victorious, without any symptoms!

Real faith holds on the blessings of God. Real faith is a child of the knowledge of God’s Word. Dr. Simpson acted on the Word and got real faith from it. Instead of trying to believe, he just acted upon the Word. **He acted like the Word is true.** Whatever you’re believing God for, act like His Word is true for you.

"The Holiness of God" (PT 4)

One of His Attributes

"THE WHOLE EARTH IS (Isaiah 6:3) FULL OF HIS GLORY"

v. 3— *"And one cried unto another, and said, "Holy, holy, holy is the Lord of hosts; the whole earth is full of His glory."*

1. What we see here is the word 'glory', which in Hebrew word 'kabowd' means 'glory, honour, glorious, abundance, riches, splendor, reputation, dignity, reverence. That word 'kabowd' comes from another word 'kabad' [say 'ka-vad'], which means _____.
2. The glory of God is the person of _____.

Hebrews 1:3 AMPC: "Jesus is the sole expression of the glory of God [the Light-being, the out-raying or radiance of the Divine], and He is the perfect imprint and very image of [God's] nature..."

3. For example in Genesis 1:1-3:

- In the beginning God (prepared, formed, fashioned, and) created the heavens and the earth.
- The earth was without form and an empty waste, and darkness was upon the face of the very great deep. The Spirit of God was moving (hovering, brooding) over the face of the waters.
- And God said, "Let there be light; and there was light".

4. For example in John 1:1-4:

- In the beginning [before all time] was the Word (Christ), and the Word was with God, and the Word was God Himself.
- He was present originally with God.
- All things were made and came into existence through Him; and without Him was not even one thing made that has come into being.
- In Him was LIFE, and the LIFE was the LIGHT of men.

5. For example in Luke 3:21-22:

- Now when all the people were baptized, and when Jesus also had been baptized, and [while He was still] praying, the [visible] heaven was opened.
- And the Holy Spirit descended upon Him in bodily form like a dove, and a voice came from heaven, saying, "You are My Son, My Beloved! In You I am well pleased and find delight!"

6. **The prophecy fulfilled in Isaiah 40:5 AMPC:** And the glory (majesty and splendor) of the Lord shall be revealed, and all flesh shall see it together; for the mouth of the Lord has spoken.

7. Define the glory of God is _____.
8. The glory of God is the _____ of God made manifest. The glory of God is the infinite beauty and greatness of God's manifold perfections.
- **Leviticus 10:3 NLT:** Then Moses [_____] said to Aaron [_____], "This is what the Lord meant when He said, "I will display My holiness through those who come near Me. I will display My glory before all the people."
 - **Psalms 27:4 TLB:** "The one thing I want from God, the thing I see most of all, is the privilege of meditating in His Temple, living in His Presence every day of my life, delighting in His incomparable perfections and glory."
9. **Isaiah 42:8 VOC:** The Lord said, "I am the Eternal One. "I AM" is My Name. My beauty is unique, a weighty splendor all My own. And nothing else—no idols could possibly gain My praise."
10. Interesting here in **John 17:5 AMPC:** Jesus said, "And now, Father, glorify Me along with Yourself and restore Me to such majesty and honor in Your Presence as I had with You before the world existed."
11. Another interesting: **John 17:22-23 AMPC:** Jesus said, "I have given to them the glory and honor which You have given Me, that they may be one [even] as We are **ONE**: I in them and You in Me, in order that they may become **ONE** and **PERFECTLY UNITED**, that the world [unsaved, lost] may know and [definitely] recognize that You sent Me and that You have loved them [even] as You have loved Me."
- When God gives His glory, He gives _____. That is the glory of God—He gives Himself in fullness and never partially. And those who seek the glory of God must learn that God truly desires to give Himself to us, which means He wants to enjoy fullness.
 - Jesus was not seeking more power, or honor, or mighty, or majesty. He yearned for the Father Himself. It was though He prayed, "My Father, I cannot exist without Your intimacy, any longer. I hunger for oneness, closeness! That's there be no distance, though You fill all."
 - Jesus was in the bosom of the Father before the world was. He was one with the Father, and that was glory. It was union with Him that was the delight and glory of His being. Three things Jesus had:
