"What can you believe?"

"...but if You can do anything, have compassion on us, and help us." Jesus said unto him, "If you can believe, all things are possible to him that believes." (Mark 9:22-23)

A man brought his demon-possessed son to Jesus and said, "If You can do anything, have compassion on us and help us."

Jesus said in essence (at bottom), "It's not a question of what I can do; the question is, "What can you believe?" If you can believe, all things are become possible for you. It's not up to Me; it's up to you. I don't decide if your son gets healed—you do. I have the ability, but it's up to you whether or not My ability is released."

Over and over again in the Scriptures God "puts the ball back in our court." We've been crying out to God, saying, "Oh, God move. Oh, God, do something! Meanwhile, He's been saying, "You believe; then I'll move."

God gave us His Word and His faith. After we use the faith He gave us to believe the Word He gave us, it's His turn to move again.

God really gave us the easy part of the covenant. But a lot of times, we've avoided our responsibility. It's easier to just lean back and wait for God to do everything.

But that never worked for the people under Jesus' ministry. Jesus taught the Word to give people something to believe; then they had to act on their faith in that Word.

According to Jesus' own Words, approximately 70% of the people healed under His ministry did so as a result of their own faith. As a result of your faith, all things are possible to you!

"The Holiness of God" (PT 8)

One of His Attributes

"a live coal"

(Isaiah 6:1-3, 6-7)

v. 1—...and the train of His robes filled the Temple. (MSG) or ...the Temple was filled with His glory." (TLB)

v. 2-3—Angel-seraphs hovered above Him, each with six wings. With two wings they covered their faces, with two wings covered their feet, and with two wings they flew. And they called back and forth one to the other, "Holy, Holy, Holy is the Lord Almighty; the whole earth is filled with His glory..." (MSG) "six-winged angels of fire" (TLB)

v. 6—Then one of the angel-seraphs flew to me (Isaiah). He held a live coal that he had taken with tongs from the altar. He touched my mouth with the coal and said, (MSG)

v. 7— "Look. This coal has touched your lips. Gone your guilt, your sins wiped out." Or "Now you are pronounced 'not guilty' because this coal has touched your lips. Your sins are all forgiven." (TLB)

1. Let us look at the story of Elijah, the prophet at Mt. Carmel in 1 Kings 18:30:

- **NOTICE:** And Elijah _____ the altar of the Lord that was broken down.
- Isaiah 56:7: "...for My House shall be called an House of prayer for all people."
- Jesus said, "Destroy this Temple and in three days I will **build it up.**" (John 2:19)

2. Read again 1 Kings 18:31-35:

- Elijah took 12 stones, one to represent each of the tribes of Israel, and used the STONES to rebuild the Lord's altar. Then he dug a TRENCH about 3 feet wide around the ALTAR. He piled WOOD upon the altar and cut the young BULL into pieces and laid the pieces on the wood. "Fill four barrels with water", he said, "and pour the water over the dead young bull and the wood." After they had done this he said, "DO IT AGAIN". And they did. "Now, DO IT ONCE MORE!" And they did; and the water ran off the altar and filled the trench.
- 1 Kings 18:36-37: At the customary time for offering the evening sacrifice, Elijah walked up to the altar and prayed, "O' Lord God of Abraham, Isaac, and Israel, prove today that You are the God of Israel....O' Lord, answer me! Answer me so these people will know that You are God and that You have turned their heart back again."

- James 5:16-17 AMPC: "...the earnest (heartfelt, continued) prayer of a righteous man makes tremendous power available [dynamic in its working]. Elijah was a human being with a nature such as we have [with feelings, affections, and a constitution like ours]; and he prayed earnestly for it..."
 - Matthew 3:11: John the Baptist told people, "...He shall baptize you with the Holy Spirit, and with fire."
 - Jeremiah 20:9: Jeremiah said, "...but His Word was in my heart as a BURNING FIRE shut up in my bones..."
 - Mark 8:34: Jesus said, "Whosoever will come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up His cross, and follow Me." Or Paul said in Galatians 2:20, "I am crucified with Christ, nevertheless I live; not yet I, but Christ lives in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave Himself for me".
 - Luke 9:62: Jesus said unto him, "NO MAN, having put his hand to plough, and looking back, is fit for the Kingdom of God." Also Hosea 10:12: "Sow to yourselves in righteousness, reap in mercy; BREAK UP YOUR FALLOW GROUND: for it is time to seek the Lord, till He come and RAIN RIGHTEOUSNESS upon you."
3. Look at 1 Kings 18:38: Immediately the fire of the Lord flashed down from heaven and burned up the YOUNG BULL, the WOOD, the STONES, and the DUST. It even licked up all the WATER in the TRENCH!
- Let us look at these symbols:
 - ☞ **YOUNG BULL** (calf) symbolizes: idolatry, false worship, stubbornness, threatening situation, warfare, opposition.
 - ☞ **WOOD** symbolizes: dependence on human, carnal reasoning, lust.
 - ☞ **STONE** symbolizes: hardness of heart or dead.
 - ☞ **DUST** symbolizes: death, curse, frailty of man.
 - ☞ **WATER** symbolizes: stagnant (instability), muddy, polluted (man's false doctrine/teaching/way), troubled mind, haughty spirit, unkind, causing strife, murmuring, unappealing, lies, wickedness.
 - ☞ **TRENCH** (or ditch) symbolizes: habit, trap, snare, religious tradition, addiction, lust, passion, sin, deception, flesh desire.
 - ☞ **ALTAR** symbolizes: your _____
4. Go back Isaiah 6:7 ERV: Then he (angel-seraph) touched my mouth with the hot or live coal and said, "When this hot coal touched your lips, your guilt was taken away, and your sins **WERE ERASED.**"
