## DAY OF HEALING

*"Let God be true in your life"*

**"God forbid: yea, let God be true, but every man a liar..." (Romans 3:4)**

Paul was saying to the Romans, "You have to choose what you're going to believe". Every person in this world has to decide what is going to be true in his life.

Notice, Paul didn't say, "God is true". He said, "Let God be true". You is the understanding subject of the sentence. That means *you are to let God be true in your life*. Are you going to let God be true or let the problem be true?

The Bible says, "By Jesus' stripes you were healed." (Isaiah 55:5; 1 Peter 2:24) A lot of people say, "I know that's what the Bible says, but I don't feel very good." Well, they've chosen to let their symptoms be truth and God a liar. They've chosen to let the problems be truth and God a liar. They're living on the negative side of life, always focusing on their problems instead of God's Word.

You can't focus on the problem and go over in victory; and you can't focus on the answer and go under in defeat. So

what are you focusing your attention on?

We have to let God be true, switch over to the realm of faith, and declare, "Who cares what its looks or feel like? The Bible says, "I'm healed!"

You may know God's Word is true, but Paul says in this Scripture that you have to choose what is truth in your life. Are you going to believe symptoms and circumstances, or are you going to believe God?

**CONFESSION:** I choose to let God's Word be truth in my life. I steadfastly focus on His Word and receive what God says in mine. Amen.

## His Grace is SUFFICIENT!

Each time he said, “My grace is all you need. My power works best in weakness.” 2 Corinthians 12:9a (NLT)

This was an extraordinary woman. She was a Samaritan, a race of people that the Jews utterly despised as having no claim on their God, and she was an **outcast and looked down upon by her own people**. This is evidenced by the fact that she came alone to draw water from the community well when, during biblical times, drawing water and chatting at the well was the social highpoint of a woman’s day. However, this woman was rejected and marked as immoral, an unmarried woman living openly with the sixth in a series of men.

The story of the woman at the well teaches us that **God loves us in spite of our bankrupt lives. God values us enough to actively seek us, to welcome us to intimacy, and to rejoice in our worship.** As a result of Jesus’ conversation, only a person like the Samaritan woman, **an outcast from her own people**, could understand what this means. To be wanted, to be cared for when no one, not even herself, could see anything of value in her—this is grace indeed.

But there are many other valuable truths we glean from this story. We learn that:

- 1) Only through Jesus can we obtain and receive eternal life: “Jesus answered, ‘Everyone who drinks this water will be thirsty again, but whoever drinks the water I give him will never thirst. Indeed, the water I give him will become in him a spring of water welling up to eternal life’” (John 4:13–14; John 14:6).
- 2) Jesus’ ministering to those outcasts of the Jewish society (the Samaritans) reveals that all people are valuable to God and that Jesus desires that we demonstrate love to everyone . . . **including even our enemies** (John 4:7–9; Matthew 5:44).
- 3) Jesus is the Messiah! (John 4:25–26; 1:41; Matthew 27:22; Luke 2:11).
- 4) Those who worship God, worship Him in spirit and truth (John 4:23–24; Psalm 145:18).

5) Our testimony about Jesus is a powerful tool in leading others to believe in Him: “Many of the Samaritans from that town believed in him because of the woman's testimony, ‘He told me everything I ever did.’ So when the Samaritans came to him, they urged him to stay with them, and he stayed two days. And because of his words many more became believers. They said to the woman, ‘We no longer believe just because of what you said; now we have heard for ourselves, and we know that this man really is the Savior of the world’” (John 4:39–42).

Also, we learn from Jesus’ chatting with the woman at the well three important truths about salvation:

1) Salvation comes only to those who recognize their desperate need for the spiritual life they do not have. Living water can be obtained only by those who recognize that they are spiritually thirsty.

2) Salvation comes only to those who confess and repent of their sin and desire forgiveness. **Before this immoral woman could embrace the Savior, she had to concede the full burden of her sins.**

3) Salvation comes only to those who take hold of Jesus as their Messiah. For the absolute truth is that salvation is found in no one else! (John 14:6; Acts 4:12).

Heavenly Father, Wow, Your Grace is more than enough. Thank you for the wonderful history lesson of how to apply to ourselves today. I give all glory to You, exalt Your name for You are one true God! Oh, Lord give me relief from my unbelief. Help me be a godly person who is quick to give grace, even when it’s the last thing I want to do. Thank You for the grace You extend to me each and every day. I don’t know how to change things, but I’m committed to living out Your truth today and being obedient to what You put in front of me today. In Jesus’ Name, Amen.
