"Let My grace works for you"

(Acts 11:22-26)

"When Barnabas arrived and saw God's grace in action, he was glad, and he urged them all to remain resolutely loyal to the Lord." (v. 23 BARCLAY)

1. Last week, at the prayer conference in Kansas City, Pastor Eric spend time in the presence of God and received the message from the Lord to pastors and layperson for the churches and quoted, "Let My grace works for you".
2. You see the name "Barnabas" means "son of consolation".
 - 2 Thessalonians 2:16-17: "Now our Lord Jesus Christ Himself, and God, even our Father, who had loved us, and had given us **everlasting consolation** and *good* hope through *grace*. Comfort your hearts, and establish you in every *good* word and work."
 - The word "**consolation**" is the same word—The Holy Spirit is your **Comforter**.
3. Then Barnabas went to **Tarsus** to look for **Saul**. (Acts 11:25)
 - The word "**Tarsus**" means "a flat basket". "**Saul**" means "desired, asked for, demanded, required". Same as in John 14:13-14.
 - "And God will generously provide all you need. Then you will always have everything you need and plenty left over *to share with others*." (2 Corinthians 9:8 NLT)
 - "For God is the One who provides seed for the farmer and then bread to eat. In the same way, He will provide and increase your resources and then produce a great harvest of generosity in you." (2 Corinthians 9:10 NLT)
4. Now it is your responsibility to look for "**Saul**"—that you "ask, desire, demand, or require". When Barnabas found "Saul" and he brought him back to Antioch—first called "Christians". When you find "Saul" and bring it back in your church and share it with us His gracious Word. **There are 5 natural senses:**
 - _____: Barnabas saw the grace of God. (Acts 11:23) The grace of God is a _____. His name is _____.
 - _____: Let us *hear* the gracious Words of Jesus. (Luke 4:22)
 - _____: Now that you have *tasted* that the Lord is gracious. (1 Peter 2:3)
 - _____: She had heard all about the wonderful miracles Jesus (Grace) did, and that is why she came up behind Him through crowd and *touched* His clothes (shawl-saul). (Mark 5:27)
 - _____: And he came near, and kissed him: and he *smelled* the smell of his raiment, and blessed him, and said, "See, the smell of my son is as the smell of a field which the Lord had blessed." (Gen. 27:27)
