## 5 Simple Ways You Can Make This Lesson Stick With your Kids

### Hannah - Prayer Warrior

#### **IN THE CAR:**

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home:

Hannah wasn't afraid to pray for something that seemed like it was impossible because she knew God can do anything. Hannah believed that God would hear her prayers. Heroes know anytime we need anything great or small, we should pray and ask God for His help. 1 Samuel 1:9-20,

#### **HANGING OUT:**

Make this week's lesson real:

If you have a prayer journal, share that with your kids. If not, share with the kids a time that God answered one of your prayers.

#### **AT DINNER:**

Here are some great discussion starters:

- How did God answer Hannah's prayer?
- Do you think God still answers prayer and does miracles?
- Have you picked a time to meet with God and pray every day this week?

#### **AT BEDTIME:**

Quiz your child on this summer's memory verse:

"Psalm 118:14 "The LORD makes me powerful and strong; he has saved me." (GNT)

#### **PARENT TIME:**

What you need to know:

A strong habit of prayer takes time and serious commitment, but it is worth the investment! Ask God to help you and your kids to develop a daily habit of meeting with him in prayer.
