



Growth Group Questions

This week's passage: Leviticus 20

1. In the sermon we learned that Jesus is “the original fire and brimstone” preacher; that is, Jesus was the first to announce the gospel and he was very clear about hell. Check out Matthew 11:20-30. What can we learn about the way Jesus taught about hell so that we use the doctrine appropriately?

2. Scan Leviticus 20 again – why do you think these particular sins were worthy of the death penalty? Which are most surprising to be worthy of death?

3. In the sermon we saw a connection to the warning passages in the Book of Hebrews. There are five and we looked at the second (3:7-4:1). These warnings exhort us to be wary about the possibility of falling away. Have you known people who seemed to be Christian but then completely abandoned God? What are some similarities or parallels between them that you think perhaps might be telling patterns?

4. What are some summer goals you have this year, in terms of Christlikeness, spiritual disciplines, conquering sins, making better use of your time, or general wisdom growth? Be specific. Take notes on what others say so you can be praying for their goals as well.

5. Discuss as a group: what can you do to stay in touch over the summer? Perhaps you can schedule a few meet-ups, lunches, outings, projects to do together, etc.

6. The first CFC Course is on *Apologetics*, defending the Christian faith to unbelievers. This is a tremendous way to boost your own faith and also helpful to build your confidence in talking with unbelievers about the gospel. It is Saturday **June 15th, 8AM**. Will you be there?
