SERVING OPPORTUNITIES

Meals on Wheels (Month of November) – If you are able to help deliver meals there is a sign-up sheet in the foyer. This project consists of picking up meals from the Gillespie Center. Thanksgiving – Serving at the Salvation Army: Thursday November 27
We will serve from 6:00 AM to around 10:00 AM (possibly sooner)
We have the opportunity to donate items that are needed to make this mission project a success. (Items needed: foil pans, to-go plates, pre-made potato salads, eggs, whole milk, mild cheese, Family sized cans of green beans and corn, macaroni noodles, celery, yellow onions, cornmeal, cranberry sauce, desserts)
Thanksgiving morning we will meet at the Salvation Army (3460 Carter Hill Road Montgomery 36111) at 6:00 AM. We will be assigned different job duties such as prepping food, cutting and plating desserts, making to-go plates, and possibly delivering plates to shut-ins.
This will be such a blessing and one you will not want to miss out on.

Christmas – Our church will be adopting 4 families through the Autauga Christmas Team. We will provide Christmas dinner as well as gifts. An angel tree will be placed in the foyer. Each angel will contain an item to be donated. You can take an angel and purchase the items. You will return the items unwrapped and place them under the tree in foyer. The weekend before Christmas all donations will be delivered to the families. If you would like to help with delivery, please let Alicia Goff (334-568-9603) know.
Collection will begin November 16 and run through December 14.
Please be in prayer for these families that will be sent our way. And once you choose your angel be in prayer for the person receiving that item.

Homeless Ministry (January) – We will have a collection time for items that will be needed for the outreach. (Example of items: toboggans, gloves, pop top food items, ChapStick, Gatorade, socks, snacks, XL Ziplock bags)
We will meet at the church fellowship hall to prepare and pack sack lunches along with the care packages that will be handed out. Once preparations have been made, we will split into teams to go out and deliver lunches and care packages along with praying and sharing the gospel.
