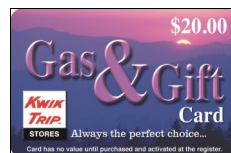
**Hy-Vee and Farway Receipts.** At this time we will not be collecting them. We hope in the future that this will be picked up again.
