THIS WEEK'S LESSON: THANK YOU FOR MAKING ME



IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home: God is our creator, and he has a special plan for all of us. That's a great reason to be thankful, and a great reason to be obedient. Jeremiah 1, God calls Jeremiah



HANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:

Spend some time this week talking about the gifts God has given each person in your family. Thank God for those gifts, and ask the kids how those gifts can serve God?



AT DINNER:

Here are some great discussion starters:

- What gifts did God give Jeremiah?
- How did Jeremiah use those gifts for God?
- How can we thank God for the gifts he has given us?



AT BEDTIME:

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse:

"Give praise to the Lord, proclaim his name; make known among the nations what he has done." 1 Chronicles 16:8 (NIV)



PARENT TIME:

What you need to know:

God wants us to be thankful to him in prayer, but we can also be thankful by our service. Pray for God to direct you and your children to discover your gifts and use them to further his kingdom.
