THIS WEEK'S LESSON: THANK YOU FOR SAVING ME



IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home: God sent his son, Jesus, to die for our sins. We can thank God for his amazing love and for wanting a relationship with us. Luke 7:36-50, A woman anoints Jesus' feet.



HANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:

Do some cleaning around the house with the kids. Ask them what they thought it was like for the woman to wash Jesus' feet. How did her actions show her gratitude to Jesus?



AT DINNER:

Here are some great discussion starters:

- How did the sinful woman show her gratitude to Jesus?
- What did Jesus do for us?
- How can we thank Jesus for forgiving our sins?



AT BEDTIME:

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse:

"Give praise to the Lord, proclaim his name; make known among the nations what he has done." 1 Chronicles 16:8 (NIV)



PARENT TIME:

What you need to know:

Jesus came to do what we could never do for ourselves: he paid the price for our sins. Thank Jesus every day for what he has done for you. Thank him with your kids, and remind them of all Jesus has done for us.
