THIS WEEK'S LESSON: HEAVEN SOUNDS AWESOME!



IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home:

The Bible ends with a few more books from Jesus' closest friends and followers, including a stunning book of prophecy about the end of times. These books encourage us to keep the faith and remember God is in control. Revelation 21:1-7, A New Heaven and Earth



MANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:

Ask the kids to teach you the hand motions they learned to help them remember the last nine books of the Bible. See if they can remember all of the books of the Bible from the beginning.



AT DINNER:

Here are some great discussion starters:

- Why did some of the letters in the Bible warn against false teachers?
- What is the book of Revelation all about?
- What has Jesus promised he is preparing for us?



AT BEDTIME:

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse:

M PARENT TIME:

What you need to know:
