THIS WEEK'S LESSON: KEEPING THE FIRE GOING

IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home:

When the camping trip is over, make sure that the campfire is out. Kids will learn that with the promised Holy Spirit, the fire of good news will never go out. Acts 2:1-12, The Holy Spirit Comes.

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TANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:

What are some things you never leave home without? Ask your kids the same question, and ask them why we need the Holy Spirit at all times.

AT DINNER:

Here are some great discussion starters:

- Whom did Jesus send to help the early church carry on his work?
- How did the Holy Spirit enable the early church to grow?
- How can we receive the Holy Spirit?

AT BEDTIME:

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse: "God began a good work in you. And I am sure that he will carry it on until it is completed. That will be on the day Christ Jesus returns." - Philippians 1:6 (NIRV)



PARENT TIME:

What you need to know:

The Holy Spirit comes when we accept Jesus as our Savior, but we only grow in the Spirit if we spend time with the Lord. Set aside some extra time this week for your own spiritual growth, and encourage your kids to do the same!
