THIS WEEK'S LESSON:



IN THE CAR:

As you're driving, ask your child who their favorite Bible character is that they learned about this week. (Some examples are Joshua, the judges, Ruth, the kings, Ezra, Nehemiah, and Ruth.)



PLAYING:

Using a Children's Bible, pick out a story to read together from one of the twelve books of history (Joshua through Esther). This might be Joshua and the Battle of Jericho, David and Goliath, or Queen Esther.



■ EATING:

Before you eat your meals, ask God to help your family choose to serve Him.



SNUGGLING:

Cuddle up with your little ones and read Joshua 24:15. Talk about how it's best for your family to choose to serve God.
