IN THE CAR:

As you drive, talk about the path you're taking to wherever you're going. Explain how you have to stay on your side of the road to be safe. Compare this to the early churches. Sometimes they didn't stay in their lane; they wanted to argue about silly things which caused lots of problems. They had to be redirected by Paul to stay focused on Jesus.



PLAYING:

While you're together, help your preschooler write a letter, just like Paul did. This could be to someone pretend or real. Help them to write words of encouragement for the reader of the letter to keep following Jesus and make good choices.



EATING:

Before you eat your meals, ask God to help you get along with others.



SNUGGLING:

Cuddle up with your little ones and read 1 Corinthians 1:10 together. Talk about how God wants us to love and get along with each other.
