1. What does the woman in the song want from guys?
2. What does she mean, "Wish they see me for me, the real me?"
3. What does she say guys mostly see when they see her?
4. How do you feel when guys are just looking at your outward appearance?
5. What does it mean to be a sex object?
6. How do you think pornography feeds into girls/women being viewed as sex objects?
7. Read verse 1. Have you experienced this kind of sexual harassment (being touched and spoken to inappropriately)? How? How did this make you feel?
8. Look at verse 2. Do you see the part that speaks about being sexually harassed through social media? Has this happened to you or have you seen this happen to others?
9. What is the difference between flirting and sexual harassment?
10. Is there anything that you can do to help guys see the real you? If so, what?
11. What should you do when you are sexually harassed – in person or on social media?
12. What should you do when you see other girls/women being sexually harassed – in person or on social media?
13. Read the last part of verse 2, which starts with "Our society is something..." How can we help change society so that girls and women are no longer viewed and treated as sex objects, but as precious, special and valuable people who have great worth and have deep thoughts and feelings?
14. How will this help empower girls/women to be all they were created to be?
15. In the Bible in Proverbs 31:30-31 it says, "Charm is deceptive, and beauty is fleeting; but a woman who fears the LORD is to be praised." What does this mean in light of what we have been talking about? What is a woman who fears the Lord like? What does this tell guys to focus on?
