

**Sexual Harassment
Mentoring Conversation Sheet
(Guys)**

1. What does the woman in the song want from guys?
2. What does she mean, “Wish they see me for me, the real me?”
3. What does she say guys mostly see when they see her?
4. What does it mean to be a sex object?
5. How do you think pornography feeds into girls/women being viewed as sex objects?
6. How do you think girls/women feel when you look at them and speak to them like they are sex objects?
7. Read verse 1. Have you participated in or seen other guys sexually harassing girls/women in the way it is spoken about in verse 1 (Physically and verbally)?
8. Look at verse 2. Do you see the part that speaks about being sexually harassed through social media? Have you seen this happen to girls? Have you participated in this kind of sexual harassment?
9. Do you think girls ask to be sexually harassed because of the way they dress? Does this make it right? Why/Why not?
10. What is the difference between flirting and sexual harassment?
11. When you have seen girls being sexually harassed in person or on social media, do you do anything or say anything?
12. What should you do when you see girls/women being sexually harassed – in person or on social media?
13. What would you do if you saw your sister or mother being sexually harassed – in person or on social media?
14. Read the last part of verse 2, which starts with “Our society is something...” How can we help change society so that girls and women are no longer viewed and treated as sex objects, but as precious, special and valuable people who have great worth and have deep thoughts and feelings?
15. How will this help empower girls/women to be all they were created to be?

16. In the Bible in Proverbs 31:30-31 it says, "Charm is deceptive, and beauty is fleeting; but a woman who fears the LORD is to be praised." What does this mean in light of what we have been talking about? What is a woman who fears the Lord like? What does this tell guys to focus on?
