1. What does the woman in the song want from guys?
2. What does she mean “Wish they see me for me, the real me?”
3. What does she say guys mostly see when they see her?
4. (Girls) How do you feel when guys are just looking at your outward appearance?
5. What does it mean to be a sex object?
6. (Guys) How do you think girls/women feel when you look at them and speak to them like they are just sex objects?
7. (Girls) Look at verse 1. Have you experienced this kind of sexual harassment (being touched and spoken to in inappropriate ways)? How? How did this make you feel?
8. (Guys) Look at verse 1. Have you participated in or seen other guys sexually harassing girls/women in the way it is spoken about in verse 1 (Physically and verbally)?
9. (Girls) Look at verse 2. Do you see the part that speaks about being sexually harassed through social media? Has this happened to you or have you seen this happen to others?
10. (Guys) Look at verse 2. Do you see the part that speaks about being sexually harassed through social media? Have you seen this happen to girls? Have you participated in this kind of sexual harassment?
11. (Guys) When you have seen girls being sexually harassed in person or on social media, do you do anything or say anything? What do you do or what should you do?
12. (Girls) What can you do to demand respect from guys?
13. (Girls) What should you do when you are sexually harassed – in person or on social media?
14. (Girls) What should you do when you see other girls/women being sexually harassed?
15. Read the last part of verse 2, that starts with “Our society is something...” How can we help change society so that girls and women are no longer viewed and treated as sex objects, but as precious, special and valuable people who have deep thoughts and feelings?
