However, a key part of his ministry will be to lead us through a 5-Step process designed to strengthen Maranatha's effectiveness in preparation for our next Senior Pastor.



1. CONNECT WITH PEOPLE:

Jeff will conduct 'listening interviews' with many of Maranatha's people to discern key issues that may need addressing. Please be willing to share your thoughts when contacted for an interview.

2. ASSESS CHURCH HEALTH:

A Transition Team will use various tools and activities to get a clear, up-to-date picture of Maranatha and surrounding community, and to celebrate what God has done in and through the church.

3. FACILITATE ACTION:

The church will determine the most appropriate steps to deal with issues that may be hindering fruitful ministry.

4. LEAD STRATEGIC PLANNING:

The church leadership team works to clarify or develop our biblical mission and a compelling vision, discover our core values, and craft a strategy to put them into effective ministry.

5. COACH PASTOR SEARCH:

When the church has achieved sufficient health, unity and vision clarity, the Interim Pastor can be a key resource in the search for our next Senior Pastor.
