- 2.) Sign the liability/release form per student and return it to me no later than **April 28th**.

Drop off Location and Time: We will be meeting Sunday, July 7th at 10:30am in the Student Center at StoneBridge Church. Don't be late! Our group will be prayed for at the beginning of the 11:00am service and will pack the vans and leave immediately after!

Pick up Location and Return Time: We will be returning Friday, July 12th at 1pm. (This is a tentative time, we will keep you updated.) Pick up will be in the D parking lot closest to the Student Center at StoneBridge Church.

Meal Details: All meals are included in the total cost of this trip except lunch on **Sunday, July 7th**. Please be sure your student brings a sack lunch and a drink for on the way to Indianapolis Sunday, July 7th. A meal will be provided on the way back from Indianapolis, IN on Friday, July 12th if need be.

Trip Location Info: We will be staying at Christ Lutheran Church (345 N Kitley Ave, Indianapolis, IN 46219) using their gym, kitchen, classrooms for sleeping, and chapel for programs. The church doesn't have showers, so GROUP will have 2 outdoor, shower tents set up, per gender, right next to the building. Bring your shower shoes and bathing suits! This location does have air conditioning.

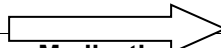
