

12 Steps to Recovery...

In the aftermath of the Great Depression of the 1930's, alcoholism became a serious problem. To help in recovery, Alcoholics Anonymous created the first 12 step program. It proved to be so successful that it has become the bible for helping people with alcoholism, drug abuse, and other addictive and dysfunctional behaviors.

The 12 Steps are designed to break bad habits, not mechanically with tricks and instant cures, but by changing the person from the inside out. Participants desire to become a better person, and want to leave their old self-destructive ways behind. In a way, it's like being reborn, a chance to start fresh, free of the baggage that they've been carrying around for many years. It's a transformation from having the addiction control the person, to putting the person in control of their lives.

Step One begins by admitting that we are powerless over our addictions and that our lives have become unmanageable.

In Step Two, we discover that we simply cannot do it alone, and that only a power greater than ourselves can restore us to sanity.

And so the journey begins...

It ends when the person has rebuilt themselves after dealing with the bad stuff that was holding them back, and filling those holes with good stuff that leads to a purpose-driven NewLife.
