

STUDENT LEADERSHIP DESCRIPTION

LUMY HS STUDENT LEADER

OVERVIEW

The role of a LUMY HS Student Leader is to support the youth ministry by building relationships with the LUMY MS students, serving as a resource and support person for the middle school students, investing in the LUMY community, and infusing LUMY as a whole with Christ-like love, inclusion, playfulness, creativity, and enthusiasm.

DESCRIPTION AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- The Student Leader will be responsible for co-leading an X-Games tribe alongside a Young Adult Intern by:
 - Participating weekly in LUMY MS: X-Games unless they are sick or out of town, **but must be able to commit to 5 out of 7 LUMY MS: X-Games this summer to provide consistency for the LUMY MS Students (dates listed below)**.
 - Showing up with enthusiasm and a welcoming and inclusive spirit.
 - Leading team chants & devotionals with the support of a Young Adult Intern.
- The Student Leaders' energy is focused on getting to know LUMY MS students and keeping the youth ministry staff informed of any concerns.
- The Student Leader will participate weekly in LUMY HS unless they are sick or out of town and will commit to growing in their own spiritual development.
- The Student Leader will attend bi-weekly leadership development meetings to grow in their faith, in their leadership, and form community with other Student Leaders.
- The Student Leader encourages spiritual growth in LUMY MS students, both in a small group setting and in everyday conversations with youth.
- The Student Leaders help ensure that all LUMY programs (both MS & HS) have a lighthearted, yet focused Christian atmosphere, with the Student Leader setting a tone of joyful enthusiasm and inclusion at these events.

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Team Structure: The Student Leader will be paired with a Young Adult LUMY Intern & other Student Leaders to co-lead a team of students at LUMY MS: X-Games.

Time Commitment:

- LUMY MS: X-Games- Sunday evenings from 5:30-8:00P
- LUMY HS: Wednesday evenings from 5:30-7:00P (time & date may change).
- Bi-weekly leadership development meetings, time TBD.

Special Gifts and Talents Preferred:

- A vibrant and mature Christian faith.
- A goal-oriented individual who is a mature, committed to God, willing to grow, with a warm personality and strong communication skills.
- A willingness to be consistently involved in LUMY.

Resources and Training Required: The youth ministry staff will provide coaching and support at the bi-weekly leadership development meetings and the Student Leader must be safe sanctuary certified.
