

I am the Vine, You are the Branches

The California-Nevada-Hawaii District held its triennial convention last May in Sacramento. It was a time when the 174 congregations in the district gathered to elect officers and decide the goals and budget for the next three years of ministry. But the convention wasn't just about ministerial business and organization. We also learned and meditated on the Scriptures together. One of the highlights was learning about the vine and branches from Cindy Steinbeck of Steinbeck Vineyard, Paso Robles, and how it illustrates the truth of our life.

Through video recordings, Cindy showed the delegates and me how grafting is done. Do you know how grafting is done?

Here's how it's done: Cindy showed us a grafting tool that looked like pliers, but it's a special tool. It cuts the rootstock to make a notch, similar to a jigsaw puzzle's female end, and it cuts the branch in a shape similar to a jigsaw puzzle's male end. It cuts the branch in exactly the opposite way, so it fits perfectly to the rootstock. The rootstock becomes the host, and the branches fit perfectly together when they are grafted. This maximizes contact and locks them together.

And it's important to be locked together. Why? Because the rootstock grows deep into the ground and provides water and nutrients to the branch. The rootstock gives life to the branch. It makes the branch grow, mature, and fruitful.

Jesus said, Abide in me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit by itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in me (John 15:4).

What a precious truth, and in a most effective way, Cindy and President Lange brought it to me and many others.

Do you want to bear fruit and bring the sweetness of God, the aroma of God, to your family, church, and friends? For sure, vacation is a big part of it, and I hope you get some this summer. But vacation alone won't make you fruitful. You need God's Son, Jesus, to be your host, your home, to whom you are completely attached. Remember this as you enjoy a glass of wine. You need to abide in Jesus, and Jesus in you.

And the good news is, Jesus wants to abide in you and you in Him. So, abide in Him.

How do you abide in Him? Keep coming to Jesus by attending the Sunday services He provides, by engaging with His Words (taught and written), by partaking in His Supper, and by joining His people to belong and live together. Jesus will nurture you and make you fruitful. May Christ make you fruitful and fill your life with sweetness.


