Updates on some of the donations:

- ◆ Cezary K. has received over \$5,000 for the food pantry.
- ◆ \$10,000 was sent to Camp EDEN for roof repairs - that's only ¼ of what's needed to cover the whole building.
- ◆ \$1,100 was sent over to Pszczyna to Tomasz Chyłka toward the purchase of the bigger building - they're needing half a million.
