Camping Season is in Full Swing in Poland! Program enters its 33rd year of changing lives.

So, what do you do when the government says "you can't", but God says "you must"? You get creative. That's what Jan Tomczyk did 33 years ago when God laid it on his heart to start a camp. Now, well into its third decade of making disciples, Camp Eden has survived Communism, managed in spite of a perennially poor economy, and introduced thousands of young people to the message of the gospel.

To the right is the camp schedule for the summer, so you can pray for each camp as it takes place.

- June 26-July 6, Youth Camp, age 13+
- July 7-16, Youth Camp, age 14+
- July 18-24, Artist Camp, age 14+
- July 26-August 4, Children's Camp, Age 8-13
- August 6-August 13, Youth Camp, age 14+
- August 15-August 24, Children's Camp, age 8-13

This acre and a half wheat field is important to Camp Eden's future growth. It stands between the camp's main lodge and worship center. It's purchase is very important for these reasons:

- It will help guard against encroachment. The owner is interested in selling, and it is important that Eden obtain ownership, rather than developers.
- It will provide needed space for future housing.
- It will guarantee important space for athletic fields, essential to Eden's future development.
