<u>Sławek Folks</u> is hosting a National Apologetics Conference in Warsaw, on Nov 30th, all tickets sold! And people from all over Poland will be driving in to be a part of this gathering.

<u>Daniel & Dorota Cichocki</u> are rejoicing over the BIG work the Lord has done over the 6 different camps they hosted this past summer. They were able to serve over 700 people: children, youth and adults. Many gave their life to Christ, as they participated in a variety of offered activities during camps, like Bible study meetings, small groups and worship.

They're especially glad to host about 80 Ukrainian young people and to build relationships with them.





They also direct the Church Growth Institute in four different locations throughout the country. These Bible Seminar Classes meet locally and focus on discipleship, sharpening one another, discovering spiritual gifts as well as

getting involved in Christian ministry.

Andrzej Karzelek and his team have done a couple of street evangelistic outreaches throughout the summer, which resulted in baptisms at the end of the season. And now they get to grow and do life with the new-born believers.



Cezary Komisarz is currently in transition and is training up and investing a lot of time into a chosen candidate for his own replacement as a senior Pastor for their congregation. He and his wife are heavily involved and supporting their local community, through various outreaches.
