

Here are a couple of good New Year revolutions!

The two ideas below can prove to be revolutionary to ministry efforts at home and in Poland.

1. Develop a special relationship with a Polish pastor.

This can be done by a church or even a Christian business. We call it a Strategic Partnership. It's when a group:

- a) takes on a major portion of a Polish pastor's monthly salary while his church is developing,
- b) sends a work team at least every two or three years to help with his ministry initiatives, and
- c) brings the Polish pastor to their church every three years so he can stretch their vision for ministry at home and abroad.



The value of such a relationship.

The time he has been able to give full-time to ministry has allowed his church to flourish, and they are working on planting another church in a larger city nearby.


In addition, Calvary Church plans to send a team to work with them next summer.
