## Church report from Zamosc.

After a leave of absence for a period of time, Piotrek Filipek has returned to the church in Zamosc. A lot has been happening since his return, as the summary below will show.



### SPIRITUAL ENCOUNTERS FOR MEN!

This is an intentional effort to disciple men, helping them mature in their roles as husbands, fathers, and leaders in the church. Three meetings have been held throughout the Fall.



### NEW MINISTRY AMONG WOMEN!

In the Fall, a new Bible study was started for women. About 25 women attend these meetings every month. Most of them are unbelievers, with no knowledge of Scripture.

In Poland, people have been discouraged for years from reading the Bible on their own. These Bible studies are a significant breakthrough. People are discovering many eternal truths they have never known before.



### "THE LIGHT IN THE ATTIC" YOUTH GROUP.

In late Fall, many youth participated in collecting food for the poor, including an orphanage, and a school for disabled children. Other activities designed to provide fellowship and further discipleship were also provided.



### "CLUB SAMUEL" CHILDREN'S MINISTRY.

Whether it is the older girls learning how to cook, or a trip to a farm, children are being befriended and loved by caring, Christian adults; something that bodes well for the future.
