TORAH TIDBITS

Deal with Reality; Walk by Faith

This portion of Scripture portrays a civilization that is remarkably a lot like our civilization. Several thousand years separate Noah and our generation, but in many ways, mostly negative, they are a lot like we are. As the Old Preacher, Solomon, himself declared: "There is nothing new under the sun," (Ecclesiastes 1:9).

Yes, we are very different from them. They traveled by donkey, or on foot—we are now designing jets that will fly from LA to Tokyo in 2 1/2 hours. They communicated by word of mouth, usually through a messenger, sometimes taking months—we communicate instantly, by phone, fax, and the internet. They used bows and arrows and swords—we use "smart bombs" and laser weapons.

Yet, we live in a society that is almost a carbon copy of their society, morally. The words of Genesis describe our civilization to a tee—"The L-rd saw how great man's wickedness on the earth had become and that every inclination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil... Now the earth was corrupt in G-d's sight and full of violence," (6:5, 11). It's not a pretty picture, but it's reality and we must deal with it. It's been estimated that there are 36 million born-again believers in the US. Regardless of the actual number, there are times when each of us can relate to Noah—immersed in a godless society that seems hell-bent on pursuing its own way, oblivious that it is a way leading to the pit. Our challenge is to emulate Noah's example—to deal with reality, but to do so by faith. We need to get quiet with the L-rd so that we can get a sharp focus on His vision for us and bulldog it—pursue the L-rd and His calling for us single-mindedly. Our biggest reality should be the presence of G-d in our life and His calling upon our life. Let's go on, boldly, in faith and watch G-d work.
